Even amongst the pandemic, we were once again successful in earning a new certification that was created and launched in direct response to the COVID outbreak. In March 2021, our facility earned the [WELL Health-Safety Rating](#) showing that our coworking space had passed the rigorous review process for adherence to high standards for occupant health and wellness. With verification in areas such as reducing surface contact, planning for healthy re-entry, supporting mental health recovery and more, our policies and operations strive to help employees, tenants and guests feel safe at The Alliance Center.

- Earned 21 of the 22 features within the rating.
- Early adopter of the rating system and one of the first in Colorado to receive it.
- Showcases our historical efforts to provide a healthy and safe workplace since many policies and operational recommendations of rating were already in place before the pandemic.

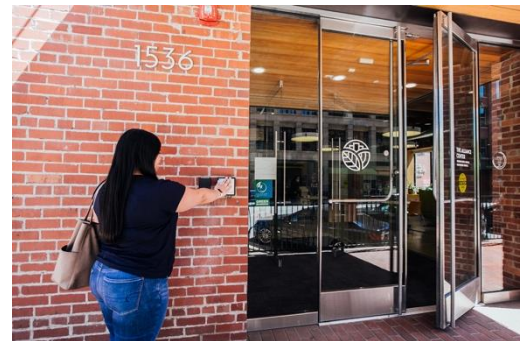


Photo of an employee using the wave-to-enter feature of The Alliance Center's front doors, which was installed to reduce surface contact.
