# REDUCE SURFACE CONTACT



## FEATURE OVERVIEW

The intent of this feature is to **reduce the amount of hand contact on high-touch surfaces.**

There are a number of vectors of disease transmission, one major one being surface contacts. Harmful pathogens can survive on surfaces infected by droplets, and as a result be spread from one occupant to the next.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF WHAT WE'VE DONE



### HANDS-FREE FRONT ENTRANCE

A motion activated wave-to-open entrance and exit mechanism is installed at our building's front entrance.



### AUTOMATED INSTALLATIONS

We have handwashing stations equipped with automated soap dispensers and faucets with compostable, single-use paper towels for hand drying.



### MOTION SENSOR LIGHTS

Our building has motion sensor lights installed throughout the facility.



### FOOT DOOR PULLS AT RESTROOMS

Foot operated door pulls are installed in restrooms to make a hands-free exit possible.
